## Numbers 5:5-10 Restitution and Sin Penalty

5 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

Restitution to the one wronged

<sup>6</sup> "Speak to the children of Israel: 'When a man or woman commits any sin that men commit in unfaithfulness against the LORD, and that person is guilty, 7 then he shall confess the sin which he has committed. He shall make restitution for his trespass in full, plus one-fifth of it, and give it to the one he has wronged.

## Priest's portion

<sup>8</sup> But if the man has no relative to whom restitution may be made for the wrong, the restitution for the wrong must go to the LORD for the priest, in addition to the ram of the atonement with which atonement is made for him. <sup>9</sup> Every offering of all the holy things of the children of Israel, which they bring to the priest, shall be his. <sup>10</sup> And every man's holy things shall be his; whatever any man gives the priest shall be his.'" NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- $\Rightarrow$  Restore to the one wronged 120% of value of the wrong.
- ☆ If there is no one to receive the restitution, then the restitution goes to God, and becomes the property of the Priest.
- $\Rightarrow$  The one who has done the wrong is out of fellowship with God and atonement is required.
- $\Rightarrow$  The one who has done the wrong is to bring a ram of atonement.
- $\Rightarrow$  The Priest makes atonement for the guilty one.
  - ☆ Atonement speaks of the work of Messiah Jesus as He becomes the final sacrifice to satisfy Almighty God's requirement for our reconciliation which is provided by His blood through faith that He might be the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. [Romans 3:21-26, Hebrews 2:14-18, 1 John 2:1-2, 4:7-11]
- Every offering of all the holy things of the Children of Israel that is brought to the Priest shall belong to the Priest.
- $\Rightarrow$  Whatever anyone gives to the Priest shall be the Priest's.
