- ♦ The question is "How long will you ignorant ones love your ignorance?

- ♦ Solomon then described the ways of prideful mankind.
- \diamond Scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge.
- ✤ If they repent of their ignorance and seek the Lord and His ways diligently, then Yahweh would pour out His Spirit on them, and make His Words known to them.

- The price for refusing the call of the Spirit and rejecting the knowledge of Yahweh, refusing to fear Him and rejecting His counsel, despising His every rebuke is described in verses 31 & 32.
- ☆ They will receive the fruit of their wickedness because the turning away of the ignorant will slay them, the complacency of fools will destroy them.
- But whoever listens to me will dwell safely, And will be secure, without fear of evil." [Proverbs 1:33]
 - \diamond There is safety in listening to the voice of Wisdom, the Holy Spirit.
 - ♦ His will is revealed in the Holy Scriptures and available to all who will diligently seek it out by careful study of His Word.
