 - \diamond Yahweh is watching, do not attempt to change property lines.
- Apply your heart to instruction, And your ears to words of knowledge. [Proverbs 23:12]
 - \diamond To gain wisdom, one must apply himself to seek it diligently with the heart, listening carefully with the ears to the words of knowledge.
- Do not withhold correction from a child, For *if* you beat him with a rod, he will not die. You shall beat him with a rod, And deliver his soul from hell.* [Proverbs 23:13-14]
 - ♦ Children need firm discipline to guide their lives in righteousness to save him from Hell's fire.
 - ♦ An undisciplined child will soon turn to evil being self centered and demanding his own way.
 - ♦ Parental guidance with proper discipline will help the child to find a righteous path to eternal life.
- \Rightarrow My son, if your heart is wise, My heart will rejoice indeed, I myself; Yes, my inmost being will rejoice When your lips speak right things. [Proverbs 23:15-16]
 - \diamond A wise son is a wonderful blessing to his parents.
 - \diamond Knowing they walk in righteousness brings great joy to the heart of his parents.
- \Rightarrow Do not let your heart envy sinners,
 - But *be zealous* for the fear of Yahweh (the LORD) all the day;

For surely there is a hereafter, And your hope will not be cut off.

- Hear, my son, and be wise; And guide your heart in the way. [Proverbs 23:17-19]
- \diamond The heart can be controlled by the will and its focus.
