 - \diamond Yahweh loves those who are faithful to His commandments and humble before Him.
 - \diamond The benefit will touch your body as well as your soul.
- Honor Yahweh (the LORD) with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase;

So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine. [Proverbs 3:9-10]

- ♦ Yahweh will bless you with abundance when you obey His commandments to tithe for the support of His spiritual leaders.

- ♦ Wisdom, knowledge and understanding were with Yahweh during creation and continue in sustaining the heavens and the earth.

 \diamond If you have faith in Yahweh, He will be your help when terror and trouble comes.

Do not say to your neighbor, "Go, and come back, And tomorrow I will give *it*," When *you have* it with you. [Proverbs 3:27-28]

 \diamond , Do not hesitate to do good when your are able to help.

 Do not strive with a man without cause, If he has done you no harm. [Proverbs 3:29-30]
 Call to pursue peaceful relationships with neighbors for safety's sake.

- Do not envy the oppressor, And choose none of his ways;
 For the perverse *person is* an abomination to Yahweh (the LORD),
 But His secret counsel *is* with the upright. [Proverbs 3:31-32]
 - ♦ We are warned to avoid desiring the wealth of the oppressor because he is an abomination to Yahweh and will be punished on the day of judgment.
 - \diamond The secret counsel of Yahweh is with the upright.
- The curse of Yahweh (the LORD) is on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just.

But shame shall be the legacy of fools. [Proverbs 3:33-35]
