The Way of Wisdom

¹·Wisdom has built her house, She has hewn out her seven pillars; ² She has slaughtered her meat, She has mixed her wine, She has also furnished her table.

³ She has sent out her maidens, She cries out from the highest places of the city, ⁴ "Whoever *is* simple, let him turn in here!"

As for him who lacks understanding, she says to him,

⁵ "Come, eat of my bread And drink of the wine I have mixed.

⁶ Forsake foolishness and live, And go in the way of understanding.

⁷ "He who corrects a scoffer gets shame for himself, And he who rebukes a wicked *man* only harms himself.

⁸ Do not correct a scoffer, lest he hate you;

Rebuke a wise *man*, and he will love you.

⁹ Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be still wiser;

Teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.

- \diamond Wisdom calls for all to seek wisdom and gain understanding.
- \diamond Then to forsake foolishness and walk in the way of understanding.
- \diamond To forsake foolishness is to truly live.

- ☆ "He who corrects a scoffer gets shame for himself, And he who rebukes a wicked man only harms himself.
 - Do not correct a scoffer, lest he hate you;

Rebuke a wise *man*, and he will love you.

Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser;

Teach a just man, and he will increase in learning. [Proverbs 9:7-9]

- \diamond The contrast between teaching the wise and just or the wicked and scoffer.
- \diamond The scoffer and the wicked will turn on you with hateful retaliation to their own destruction.
- \diamond The wise and just will love you, receive the instruction and benefit by it.
- "The fear of Yahweh (the LORD) is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

For by me your days will be multiplied, And years of life will be added to you. [Proverbs 9:10-11]

- ♦ Wisdom begins with the proper fear of Yahweh.
- \diamond Understanding comes through gaining knowledge of The Holy One.

☆ If you are wise, you are wise for yourself,

And *if* you scoff, you will bear *it* alone." [Proverbs 9:12]

- \diamond The attitude and character of an individual is personal and restricted to the one who holds it.
- \diamond The consequences are equally restricted to the individual.
- \diamond However the influence of both affects others for good or for evil.
