

Psalm 105:1-45 Give Thanks to Yahweh – Remember His works with Israel His Chosen

*The Eternal Faithfulness of the LORD*

(Exodus 7:8-11:10; 1 Chronicles 16:8-22)

<sup>1</sup> Oh, give thanks to Yahweh (the LORD)! Call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples!

<sup>2</sup> Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works!

<sup>3</sup> Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD !

<sup>4</sup> Seek Yahweh (the LORD) and His strength; Seek His face evermore!

<sup>5</sup> Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth,

<sup>6</sup> O seed of Abraham His servant, You children of Jacob, His chosen ones!

<sup>7</sup> He *is* Yahweh Eloheynuw (the LORD our God); His judgments *are* in all the earth.

<sup>8</sup> He remembers His covenant forever, The word *which* He commanded, for a thousand generations,

<sup>9</sup> *The covenant* which He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac,

<sup>10</sup> And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel *as* an everlasting covenant,

<sup>11</sup> Saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan As the allotment of your inheritance,"

<sup>12</sup> When they were few in number, Indeed very few, and strangers in it.

<sup>13</sup> When they went from one nation to another, From *one* kingdom to another people,

<sup>14</sup> He permitted no one to do them wrong; Yes, He rebuked kings for their sakes,

<sup>15</sup> *Saying*, "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm."

<sup>16</sup> Moreover He called for a famine in the land; He destroyed all the provision of bread.

<sup>17</sup> He sent a man before them – Joseph – *who* was sold as a slave.

<sup>18</sup> They hurt his feet with fetters, He was laid in irons.

<sup>19</sup> Until the time that his word came to pass, The word of Yahweh (the LORD) tested him.

<sup>20</sup> The king sent and released him, The ruler of the people let him go free.

<sup>21</sup> He made him 'adown (lord) of his house, And ruler of all his possessions,

<sup>22</sup> To bind his princes at his pleasure, And teach his elders wisdom.

<sup>23</sup> Israel also came into Egypt, And Jacob dwelt in the land of Ham.

<sup>24</sup> He increased His people greatly, And made them stronger than their enemies.

<sup>25</sup> He turned their heart to hate His people, To deal craftily with His servants.

<sup>26</sup> He sent Moses His servant, *And* Aaron whom He had chosen.

<sup>27</sup> They performed His signs among them, And wonders in the land of Ham.

<sup>28</sup> He sent darkness, and made *it* dark; And they did not rebel against His word.

<sup>29</sup> He turned their waters into blood, And killed their fish.

<sup>30</sup> Their land abounded with frogs, *Even* in the chambers of their kings.

<sup>31</sup> He spoke, and there came swarms of flies, *And* lice in all their territory.

32 He gave them hail for rain, *And* flaming fire in their land.  
 33 He struck their vines also, and their fig trees, *And* splintered the trees of their territory.  
 34 He spoke, and locusts came, Young locusts without number,  
 35 *And* ate up all the vegetation in their land, *And* devoured the fruit of their ground.  
 36 He also destroyed all the firstborn in their land, The first of all their strength.  
 37 He also brought them out with silver and gold, *And there was* none feeble among His tribes.  
 38 Egypt was glad when they departed, For the fear of them had fallen upon them.  
  
 39 He spread a cloud for a covering, *And* fire to give light in the night.  
 40 *The people* asked, and He brought quail, *And* satisfied them with the bread of heaven.  
 41 He opened the rock, and water gushed out; It ran in the dry places *like* a river.  
 42 For He remembered His holy promise, *And* Abraham His servant.  
 43 He brought out His people with joy, His chosen ones with gladness.  
 44 He gave them the lands of the Gentiles, *And* they inherited the labor of the nations,  
 45 That they might observe His statutes *And* keep His laws.

### Remembering the works of Yahweh related to Israel

- ✧ He remembers His covenant forever, The word *which* He commanded, for a thousand generations,  
*The covenant* which He made with Abraham, *And* His oath to Isaac,  
*And* confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel *as* an everlasting covenant,  
 Saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan *As* the allotment of your inheritance," [[Psalm 105:8-11](#)]
- ✧ Remembering the promise of Yahweh to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob to inherit the land of Canaan.

- ✧ When they were few in number, Indeed very few, and strangers in it.  
When they went from one nation to another, From *one* kingdom to another people,  
He permitted no one to do them wrong; Yes, He rebuked kings for their sakes,  
*Saying*, "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm." [Psalm 105:12-15]
  - ✧ As Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were in the land of Canaan, Yahweh protected them from all adversaries.
- ✧ Moreover He called for a famine in the land; He destroyed all the provision of bread.  
He sent a man before them – Joseph – *who* was sold as a slave.  
They hurt his feet with fetters, He was laid in irons.  
Until the time that his word came to pass, The word of Yahweh (the LORD) tested him.  
The king sent and released him, The ruler of the people let him go free.  
He made him 'adown (lord) of his house, And ruler of all his possessions,  
To bind his princes at his pleasure, And teach his elders wisdom. [Psalm 105:16-22]
  - ✧ Yahweh planned ahead and sent Joseph to Egypt as a slave to prepare to save his family when He brought a great famine against the land..
- ✧ Israel also came into Egypt, And Jacob dwelt in the land of Ham.  
He increased His people greatly, And made them stronger than their enemies.  
He turned their heart to hate His people, To deal craftily with His servants. [Psalm 105:23-25]
  - ✧ Jacob and his family came to Egypt because of the famine and Joseph cared for them there.
  - ✧ The land of Ham included the land of Canaan, Egypt and all of Africa.
  - ✧ The Children of Israel multiplied greatly till the Egyptians feared them and subjected them to cruel forced labor.
- ✧ He sent Moses His servant, *And* Aaron whom He had chosen.  
They performed His signs among them, And wonders in the land of Ham.  
He sent darkness, and made *it* dark; And they did not rebel against His word.  
He turned their waters into blood, And killed their fish.  
Their land abounded with frogs, *Even* in the chambers of their kings.  
He spoke, and there came swarms of flies, *And* lice in all their territory.  
He gave them hail for rain, *And* flaming fire in their land.  
He struck their vines also, and their fig trees, And splintered the trees of their territory.  
He spoke, and locusts came, Young locusts without number,  
And ate up all the vegetation in their land, And devoured the fruit of their ground.  
He also destroyed all the firstborn in their land, The first of all their strength.

  - ✧ Yahweh sent Moses and Aaron to prove the fallacy of all the idols of Egypt against God.
  - ✧ He struck Egypt with ten plagues addressing each of their gods and finally the death of the firstborn to set Israel free from bondage and head to the Promised Land.
  - ✧ The Egyptians were glad to see them leave because the fear of Yahweh had fallen upon them.
- ✧ He spread a cloud for a covering, And fire to give light in the night.  
*The people* asked, and He brought quail, And satisfied them with the bread of heaven.  
He opened the rock, and water gushed out; It ran in the dry places *like* a river.

For He remembered His holy promise, *And* Abraham His servant.  
He brought out His people with joy, His chosen ones with gladness.  
He gave them the lands of the Gentiles, And they inherited the labor of the nations,  
That they might observe His statutes And keep His laws. [\[Psalm 105:39-45\]](#)

- ✧ Yahweh led His people through the wilderness to the Promised Land by a pillar of fire and a pillar of cloud day and night.
- ✧ He provided angels food (manna) and quail to eat, and water from the rock to drink in the wilderness.
- ✧ He gave them the lands of gentile nations and they inherited the labor of nations, eating what they did not plant.
- ✧ He provided for their needs that they might obey His statutes and keep His laws.
