Assurance of God's Victory over Enemies

(<u>Psalms 57:7-11; 60:5-12</u>) A Song. A Psalm of David.

- ^{1.}O Elohiym (God), my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.
- ² Awake, lute and harp! I will awaken the dawn.
- ³ I will praise You, O Yahweh (LORD), among the peoples, And I will sing praises to You among the nations.
- ⁴ For Your mercy *is* great above the heavens, And Your truth *reaches* to the clouds.
- ⁵ Be exalted, O Elohiym (God), above the heavens, And Your glory above all the earth;
- ⁶ That Your beloved may be delivered, Save with Your right hand, and hear me.
- ⁷ Elohiym (God) has spoken in His holiness:
- "I will rejoice; I will divide Shechem And measure out the Valley of Succoth.
- ⁸ Gilead *is* Mine; Manasseh *is* Mine; Ephraim also *is* the helmet for My head; Judah *is* My lawgiver.
- 9 Moab is My washpot; Over Edom I will cast My shoe; Over Philistia I will triumph."

- ♦ With his whole heart the psalmist is promising to praise Yahweh with voice and musical instruments to the people of Israel as well as the world of Gentiles.
- ♦ Declaring the exalted greatness of the mercy and truth of Yahweh.
- ⇒ Be exalted, O Elohiym (God), above the heavens, And Your glory above all the earth;
 That Your beloved may be delivered, Save with Your right hand, and hear me. [Psalm 108:5-6]

- ♦ The exalted heights of Elohiym and His glory are acknowledged.
- ❖ His purpose is that the beloved of the Lord be delivered and saved, and that his prayer be heard.

"I will rejoice; I will divide Shechem And measure out the Valley of Succoth. Gilead *is* Mine; Manasseh *is* Mine; Ephraim also *is* the helmet for My head; Judah *is* My lawgiver.

- ♦ Elohiym has expressed His claim on the land and tribes of Israel.
- ♦ Also his view toward Moab, Edom and Philistia.
- ♦ Who will bring me into the strong city? Who will lead me to Edom?

 Is it not You, O Elohiym (God), who cast us off? And You, O Elohiym (God), who did not go out with our armies?

Give us help from trouble, For the help of man is useless.

Through Elohiym (God) we will do valiantly, For *it is* He *who* shall tread down our enemies.* [Psalm 108:10-13]

- ♦ The psalmist asked who will help them since Elohiym did not go out with their armies.
- ♦ He acknowledged that human help is useless, and that only Elohiym can help.
