- 1 Help, Yahweh (Lord), for the godly man ceases! For the faithful disappear from among the sons of men
- 2 They speak idly everyone with his neighbor; With flattering lips and a double heart they speak.
- 3 May Yahweh (the Lord) cut off all flattering lips, And the tongue that speaks proud things,
- 4 Who have said, "With our tongue we will prevail; Our lips are our own; Who is Adown (lord) over us?"
- ⁵ "For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, Now I will arise," says Yahweh (the Lord); "I will set him in the safety for which he yearns."
- 6 The words of Yahweh (the Lord) are pure words, Like silver tried in a furnace of earth, Purified seven times.
- ⁷ You shall keep them, O Yahweh (Lord), You shall preserve them from this generation forever.
- 8 The wicked prowl on every side, When vileness is exalted among the sons of men. NKJV
