 - ♦ When Jerusalem was carried away by the Babylonians, the Edomites rejoiced claiming the land as theirs.
 - ♦ The psalmist prayed for Yahweh to remember the attitude of the Edomites in judgment. [Jeremiah 49:7-22, Ezekiel 25:12-14, 35:1-15, Joel 3:19, Amos 1:11-13]
 - → He remembered the prophesy of the destruction of Babylon and expressed the joy of those who carry it out in the future. [Jeremiah 50:1 through 51:64]
