## Prayer for Deliverance from Evil Men

To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.

<sup>1</sup>·Deliver me, O Yahweh (LORD), from evil men; Preserve me from violent men,

<sup>2</sup> Who plan evil things in *their* hearts; They continually gather together *for* war.

<sup>3</sup> They sharpen their tongues like a serpent; The poison of asps *is* under their lips.

<sup>4</sup> Keep me, O Yahweh (LORD), from the hands of the wicked; Preserve me from violent men, Who have purposed to make my steps stumble.

<sup>5</sup> The proud have hidden a snare for me, and cords; They have spread a net by the wayside; They have set traps for me.

<sup>6</sup> I said to Yahweh (the LORD): "You *are* Eliy (my God); Hear the voice of my supplications, O Yahweh (LORD).

<sup>7</sup> O Yahweh (GOD) Adonay (the Lord), the strength of my salvation, You have covered my head in the day of battle.

<sup>8</sup> Do not grant, O Yahweh (LORD), the desires of the wicked; Do not further his *wicked* scheme, *Lest* they be exalted.

Facts Revealed:

 $\diamond$  David described the evil violent men from whom he seeks divine protection.

☆ Keep me, O Yahweh (LORD), from the hands of the wicked; Preserve me from violent men, Who have purposed to make my steps stumble.

The proud have hidden a snare for me, and cords; They have spread a net by the wayside; They have set traps for me. [Psalm 140:4-5]

- ♦ Again David prayed for Yahweh to protect him from the violent wicked who are determined to make him stumble and from the proud who set traps for him.
- I said to Yahweh (the LORD): "You are Eliy (my God); Hear the voice of my supplications, O Yahweh (LORD).

O Yahweh (GOD) Adonay (the Lord), the strength of my salvation, You have covered my head in the day of battle.

Do not grant, O Yahweh (LORD), the desires of the wicked; Do not further his wicked scheme, *Lest* they be exalted. [Psalm 140:6-8]

- $\diamond$  David acknowledged Yahweh as Eliy and asked Him to hear his supplications.
- $\diamond$  Yahweh Adonay has been his strength and salvation in battle.
- $\diamond$  David prayed that Yahweh frustrate the desires of the wicked lest they feel exalted.
- "As for the head of those who surround me, Let the evil of their lips cover them; Let burning coals fall upon them; Let them be cast into the fire, Into deep pits, that they rise not up again.

Let not a slanderer be established in the earth; Let evil hunt the violent man to overthrow *him*." [Psalm 140:911]

- $\diamond$  David suggested the form of punishment he seeks for his adversaries.
- $\diamond$  He prayed that Yahweh not allow a slanderer to be established in the earth.
- $\diamond$  He also suggested the judgment desired against the violent men.
- ✤ I know that Yahweh (the LORD) will maintain The cause of the afflicted, And justice for the poor.

Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence. [Psalm 140:12-13]

- ♦ David expressed his confidence that Yahweh will support the afflicted and bring justice for the poor.
- $\diamond$  The Saints will praise the Name of Yahweh as the upright dwell in His presence.
