The Assurance of God's Saving Work To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.

- 1 May Yahweh (the Lord) answer you in the day of trouble; May the name of Elohey the God of Jacob defend you;
- 2 May He send you help from the sanctuary, And strengthen you out of Zion;
- 3 May He remember all your offerings, And accept your burnt sacrifice. Selah
- 4 May He grant you according to your heart's desire, And fulfill all your purpose.
- ⁵ We will rejoice in your salvation, And in the name of Eloheynu (our God) we will set up our banners! May Yahweh (the Lord) fulfill all your petitions.
- ⁶ Now I know that Yahweh (the Lord) saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven With the saving strength of His right hand.
- ⁷ Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of Yahweh Eloheynu (the Lord our God).
- 8 They have bowed down and fallen; But we have risen and stand upright.
- 9 Save, Yahweh (Lord)! May the King answer us when we call. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ➡ David is calling the people to trust in Yahweh by his prayer that Yahweh will answer in times
 of trouble and defend you. [Psalm 20:1-4]
 - ♦ That He may send help from His sanctuary and strength out of Zion.
 - ♦ That He may remember all your offerings and accept your sacrifices.
 - ♦ That He may grant your heart's desire and fulfill your purposes.
- ➡ David declared his intent for the people to rejoice in Yahweh's Salvation and set up their banners in the name of Eloheynu. [Psalm 20:5]
 - ♦ David asked that Yahweh will fulfill all your petitions.
- David expressed his confidence that Yahweh's right hand saves His anointed (referring to the anointing given to himself as king), and answers him from heaven. [Psalm 20:6]
- ❖ Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of Yahweh Eloheynu (the Lord our God).
 - They have bowed down and fallen; But we have risen and stand upright. [Psalm 20:7-8]
 - ❖ David acknowledged that those who trust in chariots and horses have bowed down and fallen.
 - ♦ In contrast, we who remember Yahweh Eloheynu have risen and stand upright.
- ♦ Save, Yahweh (Lord)! May the King answer us when we call. [Psalm 20:9]
 - ♦ David is asking Yahweh to save them and answer when they call.
