To the Chief Musician. Set to "The Deer of the Dawn." A Psalm of David.

- ¹ Eliy, Eliy, lamah zabtaniy (My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me)? Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning?
- ² O Elohay (My God), I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent.
- 3 But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel.
- ⁴ Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them.
- 5 They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed.
- ⁶ But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.
- 7 All those who see Me ridicule Me; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
- 8 "He trusted in Yahweh (the Lord), let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!"
- 9 But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts.

- 19 But You, O Yahweh (Lord), do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me!
- 20 Deliver Me from the sword, My precious life from the power of the dog.

 - ♦ Cry of Jesus from the Cross when all the sins of the world were placed on Him. [Matthew 27:46]
- ♥ O Elohay (My God), I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent. [Psalm 22:2]
 - ♦ David expressed distress at the persistence of his grief.
- ➡ But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel.
 Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them.
 They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed. [Psalm 22:3-5]
 - ♦ David acknowledged Yahweh's exalted eminence and help of Israel in times past.
- ☼ But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.
 All those who see Me ridicule Me; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
 "He trusted in Yahweh (the Lord), let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!" [Psalm 22:6-8, Matthew 27:39, 43]
 - ♦ When Jesus was crucified He suffered the reproach and ridicule of the passing masses.
- ➡ But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts.
 - I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been Eliy (My God). Be not far from Me, For trouble is near; For there is none to help. [Psalm 22:9-11]
 - → From the womb, Jesus was set apart to do the will of God His Father and expressed His dependency on God throughout His ministry even to death on the cross. [Hebrews 10:5-10, and many other texts]

 - ♦ David promised to declare the name of Yahweh publicly and to praise Him.
 - → David called for all who fear Yahweh to praise Him, including all the descendants of Jacob and their offspring.
 - → David declared the faithfulness of Yahweh to hear the cry of His Saints, especially the Messiah.
- ☆ The poor shall eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will praise Yahweh (the Lord). Let your heart live forever!
