Facts Revealed:

☆ To You, O Yahweh (Lord), I lift up my soul.

- ☆ Trusting in Yahweh, David asked that the Lord not let him be ashamed and extended the request to all who wait on Yahweh. Also that his enemies may not triumph over him.
- ♦ On the other hand, David requested that those who deal treacherously without cause be ashamed before Yahweh.
- Show me Your ways, O Yahweh (Lord); Teach me Your paths.

Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are Elohey (the God) of my salvation; On You I wait all the day. [Psalm 25:4-5]

- \diamond David recognized his weakness and asked for divine guidance.
- \diamond David recognized that Yahweh is the God of his Salvation, and he is waiting on Him.
- ☆ Remember, O Yahweh (Lord), Your tender mercies and Your lovingkindnesses, For they are from of old.

Do not remember the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; According to Your mercy remember me, For Your goodness' sake, O Yahweh (Lord). [Psalm 25:6-7]

- ♦ We all want Yahweh to remember His tender mercies and loving kindness which He has demonstrated from the beginning.
- ♦ Our greatest need and blessing from Yahweh is forgiveness and covering of our sins and transgressions.
- ♦ In His great mercy, Yahweh has made the way for our sins to be covered and blotted out by the blood of atonement through Messiah.
- \Rightarrow Good and upright is Yahweh (the Lord); Therefore He teaches sinners in the way.

The humble He guides in justice, And the humble He teaches His way.

All the paths of Yahweh (the Lord) are mercy and truth, To such as keep His covenant and His testimonies.

For Your name's sake, O Yahweh (Lord), Pardon my iniquity, for it is great. [Psalm 25:8-11]

- ♦ The goodness and righteousness of Yahweh is demonstrated as He teaches sinners the way and guides the humble by teaching them His way.
- ♦ Those who keep His covenant and testimonies realize that all the paths of Yahweh are mercy and truth.

- \diamond Whoever fears Yahweh will be taught in the way Yahweh chooses.
- \diamond The result will be prosperity and confidence that his descendants shall inherit the earth.
- \diamond Yahweh will reveal things secret and His covenant to those who fear Him.
- \diamond David said he will always look toward Yahweh to keep his feet out of the net.

☆ Turn Yourself to me, and have mercy on me, For I am desolate and afflicted.

Look on my affliction and my pain, And forgive all my sins.

Consider my enemies, for they are many; And they hate me with cruel hatred.

Keep my soul, and deliver me; [Psalm 25:16-20]

- ♦ David called for Yahweh to look upon all his affliction and pain, to have mercy and forgive all his sins.
- \diamond To consider all the enemies who hate with cruel hatred and deliver him.
- \Rightarrow Let me not be ashamed, for I put my trust in You.
