- ³ Do not take me away with the wicked And with the workers of iniquity, Who speak peace to their neighbors, But evil *is* in their hearts.
- ⁴ Give them according to their deeds, And according to the wickedness of their endeavors; Give them according to the work of their hands; Render to them what they deserve.
- ⁵ Because they do not regard the works of Yahweh (the LORD), Nor the operation of His hands, He shall destroy them And not build them up.

 - Because they do not regard the works of Yahweh (the LORD), Nor the operation of His hands, He shall destroy them And not build them up. [Psalm 28:3-5]
 - → David desires to be held separate from the wicked so as not to partake in their punishment.

- ♦ David's prayer is for the wicked to be judged according to their own behavior because they do not consider Yahweh.
- ➡ Blessed be Yahweh (the LORD), Because He has heard the voice of my supplications!
 - Yahweh (the LORD) is my strength and my shield; My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped;
 - Therefore my heart greatly rejoices, And with my song I will praise Him. [Psalm 28:6-7]
 - → David acknowledged his trust in Yahweh who has heard his prayer, strengthened him and has been his defense
 - ♦ Therefore he rejoices with songs of Praise.
- - → David acknowledged that Yahweh is also the strength, refuge, and guide of His anointed people.
 - ♦ Worthy of all praise and gratitude.
