Prayer to God in Time of Trouble

¹ Vindicate me, O Elohiym (God), And plead my cause against an ungodly nation;
Oh, deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man!

² For You are Elohey (the God) of my strength; Why do You cast me off?
Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?

³ Oh, send out Your **light** and Your **truth!** Let them lead me; Let them bring me to Your holy hill And to Your tabernacle.

Then I will go to the altar of Elohiym (God), To El (God) my exceeding joy; And on the harp I will praise You, O Elohiym Elohay (God, my God). [\[Psalm 43:3-4\]](#)

✧ David prayed for the light and truth of Yahweh to lead him the Tabernacle on God's holy hill.

✧ There at the altar of Elohiym he will express his great joy in praise with his harp.

✧ Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me?
Hope in Elohiym (God);

For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and Elohay (my God). [\[Psalm 43:5\]](#)

✧ David repeated his question of spiritual grief, and the answer is **hope in Elohiym**.

✧ David promised to praise Elohiym for the comforting joy in the presence of Elohay.
