Oppressed by the Wicked but Rejoicing in the LORD

To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.

¹ Hear my voice, O Elohiym (God), in my meditation; Preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

² Hide me from the secret plots of the wicked, From the rebellion of the workers of iniquity,

³ Who sharpen their tongue like a sword, And bend *their bows to shoot* their arrows — bitter words,

⁴ That they may shoot in secret at the blameless; Suddenly they shoot at him and do not fear.

⁵ They encourage themselves *in* an evil matter; They talk of laying snares secretly; They say, "Who will see them?"

⁶ They devise iniquities: "We have perfected a shrewd scheme." Both the inward thought and the heart of man are deep.

⁷ But Elohiym (God) shall shoot at them *with* an arrow; Suddenly they shall be wounded.

⁸ So He will make them stumble over their own tongue; All who see them shall flee away.

⁹ All men shall fear, And shall declare the work of Elohiym (God); For they shall wisely consider His doing.

¹⁰ The righteous shall be glad in Yahweh (the LORD), and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory.

✧ David described his expected response from Elohiym.

✧ All men shall fear, And shall declare the work of Elohiym (God); For they shall wisely consider His doing.

The righteous shall be glad in Yahweh (the LORD), and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory. [\[Psalm 64:9-10\]](#)

✧ David described the expected impact on all men everywhere.

✧ The righteous will be glad and trust in Yahweh and the heart of the upright shall glory.
