

## Psalm 75:1-10

### *Thanksgiving for God's Righteous Judgment*

To the Chief Musician. Set to "Do Not Destroy."\* A Psalm of Asaph. A Song.

<sup>1</sup>We give thanks to You, O Elohiym (God), we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare *that* Your name is near.

<sup>2</sup>"When I choose the proper time, I will judge uprightly.

<sup>3</sup>The earth and all its inhabitants are dissolved; I set up its pillars firmly.

<sup>4</sup>"I said to the boastful, 'Do not deal boastfully,' And to the wicked, 'Do not lift up the horn.

<sup>5</sup>Do not lift up your horn on high; Do *not* speak with a stiff neck."

<sup>6</sup>For exaltation *comes* neither from the east Nor from the west nor from the south.

<sup>7</sup>But Elohiym (God) *is* the Judge: He puts down one, And exalts another.

<sup>8</sup>For in the hand of Yahweh (the LORD) *there is* a cup, And the wine is red; It is fully mixed, and He pours it out; Surely its dregs shall all the wicked of the earth Drain *and* drink down.

<sup>9</sup>But I will declare forever, I will sing praises to Elohey (the God of) Jacob.

<sup>10</sup>"All the horns of the wicked I will also cut off,  
*But* the horns of the righteous shall be exalted."

#### Facts Revealed:

- ✧ ·We give thanks to You, O Elohiym (God), we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare *that* Your name is near.
  - ✧ Asaph praised Elohiym giving thanks for all His wondrous works that indicate His Name is near.
- ✧ "When I choose the proper time, I will judge uprightly.  
The earth and all its inhabitants are dissolved; I set up its pillars firmly. [\[Psalm 75:1-3\]](#)
  - ✧ Speaking prophetically in the place of Elohiym, he indicated that there is an appointed time when Elohiym will judge the inhabitants of the earth, and that His judgment will be upright.
  - ✧ The earth and all its inhabitants will be dissolved even though He had set its pillars firmly. [\[2 Peter 3:10-12\]](#)
- ✧ "I said to the boastful, 'Do not deal boastfully,' And to the wicked, 'Do not lift up the horn.  
Do not lift up your horn on high; Do *not* speak with a stiff neck."  
For exaltation *comes* neither from the east Nor from the west nor from the south.  
But Elohiym (God) *is* the Judge: He puts down one, And exalts another.  
For in the hand of Yahweh (the LORD) *there is* a cup, And the wine is red; It is fully mixed, and He pours it out; Surely its dregs shall all the wicked of the earth Drain *and* drink down. [\[Psalm 75:4-8\]](#)

- ✧ Elohiym had given plenty of warnings and instructions that should have corrected the wicked.
- ✧ Elohiym exalts one and puts down another.
- ✧ The wicked will certainly drink from the cup of Yahweh receiving the full fury of His judgment.
- ☆ But I will declare forever, I will sing praises to Elohey (the God of) Jacob.  
"All the horns of the wicked I will also cut off,  
*But* the horns of the righteous shall be exalted." [\[Psalm 75:9-10\]](#)
- ✧ Asaph promised to faithfully declare the truth and sing praises to Elohey.
- ✧ The wicked will be cut off.
- ✧ The righteous will be exalted.
