Praise to the LORD for His Love and Faithfulness

A Psalm. A Song for the Sabbath day.

¹ *It is good to give thanks to YAHWEH (the LORD), And to sing praises to Your name, O Elyown (Most High);*

² *To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night,*

³ *On an instrument of ten strings, On the lute, And on the harp, With harmonious sound.*

⁴ *For You, Yahweh (LORD), have made me glad through Your work; I will triumph in the works of Your hands.*

⁵ *O Yahweh (LORD), how great are Your works! Your thoughts are very deep.*

⁶ *A senseless man does not know, Nor does a fool understand this.*

⁷ *When the wicked spring up like grass, And when all the workers of iniquity flourish, *It is* that they may be destroyed forever.*

⁸ *But You, Yahweh (LORD), *are* on high forevermore.*

⁹ *For behold, Your enemies, O Yahweh (LORD), For behold, Your enemies shall perish; All the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.*

¹⁰ *But my horn You have exalted like a wild ox; I have been anointed with fresh oil.*

¹¹ *My eye also has seen *my desire* on my enemies; My ears hear *my desire* on the wicked Who rise up against me.*

¹² *The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.*

¹⁴ *They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing,*

¹⁵ *To declare that Yahweh (the LORD) is upright; *He is* my rock, and *there is* no unrighteousness in Him.*

Facts Revealed:

☆ *It is good to give thanks to YAHWEH (the LORD), And to sing praises to Your name, O Elyown (Most High);*

◇ The Psalmist finds pleasure in giving thankful praises to the Name of Elyown on musical instruments to declare His lovingkindness and faithfulness.

- ☆ A senseless man does not know, Nor does a fool understand this.
When the wicked spring up like grass, And when all the workers of iniquity flourish, *It is* that they may be destroyed forever.
But You, Yahweh (LORD), *are* on high forevermore.
For behold, Your enemies, O Yahweh (LORD), For behold, Your enemies shall perish; All the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. [Psalm 92:6-9]
 - ◇ The wicked are allowed to flourish because they will be destroyed forever.
 - ◇ Yahweh gives them time to repent and be saved. [2 Peter 3:9]
 - ◇ Yahweh is exalted on high forever.
 - ◇ The enemies of Yahweh will be scattered and perish.
- ☆ But my horn You have exalted like a wild ox; I have been anointed with fresh oil.
My eye also has seen *my desire* on my enemies; My ears hear *my desire* on the wicked Who rise up against me. [Psalm 92:10-11]
 - ◇ The psalmist feels strengthened and exalted knowing he will see and hear the punishment of the wicked. [Matthew 25:31-46]
- ☆ The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.
Those who are planted in Beit Yahweh (the house of the LORD) Shall flourish in the courts of Eloheynuw (our God).
They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing,
To declare that Yahweh (the LORD) is upright; *He is* my rock, and *there is* no unrighteousness in Him. [Psalm 92:12-15]
