# Romans 15:1-13 Servant's Heart – Following Jesus

#### The Strong help the Weak

<sup>1</sup> We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves. <sup>2</sup> Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, leading to edification.

## Example of Christ

<sup>3</sup> For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, "The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me."

#### Instruction of Scripture

<sup>4</sup> For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope.

## Enablement from God

<sup>5</sup> Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

## Following Christ's example - Benefit to Jews And Gentiles

7 Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God. 8 Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the fathers, 9 and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written:

"For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your name." [2 Samuel 22:50, Psalm 18:49]

10 And again he says:

"Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people!" [Deuteronomy 43:32]

11 And again:

"Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!" [Psalm 117:1]

12 And again, Isaiah says:

"There shall be a root of Jesse; And He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope." [Isaiah 11:10]

#### Blessing

13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- Believers who are strong must be considerate toward the conscience of the weak so as not to destroy, but to edify.
- $\clubsuit$  Jesus set the example when He took on Himself the sins of the world.

- Scriptures were written for our guidance, comfort, and hope.
  - ☆ Knowing the final outcome strengthens us for what we may encounter as it did for Jesus. [Hebrews 12:2]
- ✤ God is the One Who can enable us to be in unity of mind that we might glorify God together.
- $\clubsuit$  Jesus became a servant to the Jews for the truth of God to confirm the promises to the fathers.
  - $\diamond$  The purpose was that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy.
  - ♦ We can see the love God has for the Gentiles in Scripture, a sample of them were referenced by Paul when he said, "As it is written:"

"For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your name." [Romans 15:9, 2 Samuel 22:50, Psalm 18:49]

And again he says:

"Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people!" [Romans 15:10, Deuteronomy 43:32]

## And again:

"Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!" [Romans 15:11, Psalm 117:1]

## And again, Isaiah says:

"There shall be a root of Jesse; And He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope." [Romans 15:12, Isaiah 11:10]
